

- mākou a'e minamina i ka pu'u kālā a ke aupuni* (song), we do not care about the government's sum of money.
- 6. n.** Maui name for *maua* 2, trees.
- 'ae. 1. vt., interj.** Yes; to say yes, consent, conform, grant, agree, approve, let, confirm, admit, permit, allow, accept, yield; approval, admission, permission. Cf. *a'e nei*. *'Ae waha*, oral agreement. *'Ae wale*, to agree easily; pliable. *Ua 'ae mai 'oia i ko'u hele*, he consented to my going. (PCP ('a(a)e.) **2. n.** Sap wrung from seaweed or leaves of plants such as taro; liquid remaining after dregs have settled, as of *pia*, arrowroot starch; saliva, drooling of the mouth. *'Ae limu*, juice remaining on the pounding board after seaweed (*limu*) is pounded; mixed with salt it is used to flavor sauce for 'ō'io or other fish. *Kahe ka 'ae o ka waha*, mouth saliva flows [mouth waters; *fig.*, to desire avidly]. **3. vs.** Fine, mashed, comminuted, as dust or powder; silky soft, as down; smooth, as well-mixed poi or bread dough. *'Ae ki*, fine portions of ti root baked in the oven; to break ti root so cooked into fine bits. *'Ae moa*, downy chicken feathers. **hō.'ae.** To make fine, pulverize, refine, soften. *He ahi 'ā nōpu hō'ae*, a hot glowing fire that pulverizes. **4. vi.** To rise, of the tide. **hō.'ae.** Caus/sim. **5. n.** A native fern (*Polypodium pellucidum*) commonly seen at KI-lau-ea Volcano. It has oblong fronds 15 to 40 cm long, once divided into about fifteen or more pairs of oblong segments, each of which bears many round fruit dots. (Neal 25.) Cf. *'ae lau nui*. **6.** Same as *'a'ae*. **7. n.** Shoots from main root portion of the *wauke* plant. See *ohi* 3. **8.** See *'ae kai*, water's edge.
- 'a'e. nvt.** To step over, get on top of, tread upon, trespass; to raise; to massage the back with the feet; to break a taboo or violate a law; counter sorcery; to inflict sorcery on a sorcerer; to get into by stepping up, as into a car; step. *Fig.*, oppressed. *'A'e kā*, *'a'e kapu*, to trespass, break a law or taboo deliberately; disrespectful of taboo. *'A'e loa*, long step, long journey. *Ua 'a'e lākou i luna o kahi la'a*, they trespassed on a taboo place; they broke an agreement, law, taboo. *'A'ohe i 'a'e i ka wela a ka lā*, not oppressed by the heat of the sun. **hō.'a'e.** Caus/sim. (PPN *kake*.)
- aea. vi.** To rise up; to raise the head; to come up from under water. *Lu'u aku a aea mai* (song), dive down and come up.
- 'aea. n.** Cord, as used in joining two or more nets into a larger one. *Rare*.
- 'ae'a. nvi.** Wandering, shiftless, unstable; to wander, stray; tramp. Cf. *hōkū 'ae'a*. *'Ae'a hauka'e*, vagrant person, tramp, beachcomber, trespasser; to trespass (*lit.*, defiled wanderer). *Kanaka 'ae'a*, wanderer, drifter, tramp (less pejorative than *'ae'a hauka'e*). *One 'ae'a*, shifting sands. **hō.'ae'a.** To cause to wander; to wander. *Na ke kaumaha i hō'ae'a iāia mai ke one hānau mai*, it was grief that caused him to wander from his homeland.
- 'a'ea. Pas/imp.** of *'a'e* 1.
- ae. ae. 1. nvi.** A prolonged sound, wail; to prolong, stretch. **ho'ae. ae.** A style of chanting with prolonged vowels and fairly short phrases, much used in love chants; to chant in this fashion; to read or recite Bible passages or multiplication tables. **2. n.** Andante.
- a'e. a'e. 1. vt.** Mixing of a dark or brilliant color with a lighter one, as feathers in a lei; of dark hair of a young person with streaks of gray; to mix, as drinks. *'Ae'a mōhala i luna o ke kukui*, streaks of silvery gray showing on the candlenut tree [said of a graying person]. **2. n.** A kind of banana with green and white striped leaves and fruits. (Neal 249.) Also *koa'e* and *manini*. **3. n.** A fish (no data).
- 'ae.'ae. 1.** Redup. of *'ae* 3. See *lōle*, *mehelu*. *Hulu 'ae'ae*, downy feathers. *Ka 'ai 'ae'ae*, soft food or poi. **hō.'ae.'ae.** To make soft, fine, etc. **2. n.** A small native shrub (*Lycium sandwicense*) growing near salt marshes and among rocks near the sea. It has light-colored bark; succulent, narrow pale-green leaves about 2.6 cm long; small white to blue-tinted flowers; and small red berries. (Neal 740.) Also *'ākulikuli 'ae'ae*, *'ākulikuli 'ōhelo*, and *'ōhelo kai*. **3. n.** Water hyssop, a succulent herb (*Bacopa monniera*). *Ni'ihau*. Cf. Neal 759. **4.** Redup. of *'ae* 4. *'Ae'ae kai*, rise of the tide; froth of the sea.
- 'a'e.'a'e.** Redup. of *'a'e*.
- ae. ā. ae. n.** A small green fish resembling the *hīnālea*, used as *pani* (food or drink taken to finish a medical treatment) for certain diseases of children of the 'ea type.
- 'Ae.'ae-a-hiwa. n.** Name of a star (no data).
- 'ae'a hau. ka'e. 1.** See *'ae'a*. **2. n.** A variety of wild sweet potato, good only as pig food.
- 'a'ei. n.** Fine net, as used for 'ōpelu and *maomao* fish; it was held open at the mouth by *kuku*, stretching poles.
- ā. ā. T. ā. interj.** Chant refrain.
- ā. ā. T. eia. interj.** Chant ending.
- 'a'e ka'a. n.** A step, as on a carriage; running board of an automobile.
- 'ae kai. n.** Place where sea and land meet; water's edge.
- 'ae. kai mokiha. n.** Ancient type of tapa (no data).
- 'aeke. lona, aeselona. n.** Falcon, vulture.
- 'aeko, aeto. n. 1.** Eagle. *Lio hulu 'aeko*, dark-gray horse; *lit.*, eagle-feather horse. (Gr. *aetos*.) **2.** Alto. *Eng.* See *'aleko*.
- 'aeko kula. n.** Golden eagle.
- a'ela. Directional part.** *a'e* + demon. *lā*. See *ex.*, *a'e* 4.
- 'ae lau niu. Same as 'ae** 5, with large leaves.
- 'ae. like. nvi.** Agreement, contract, truce, accord, deal; to come to an agreement; contracted. *Palapala 'aelike*, contract. *Nā mea 'aelike*, terms or conditions of agreement. *'Aelike ho'oku'u ma kahi*, compromise, one side gives up.
- ā. elo. vs.** Rotten, of eggs that do not hatch due to infertility. *Fig.*, spoiled, worthless. *Hua āelo*, rotten egg; *fig.*, in vain, worthless. *E mālama ho'i o hua āelo ka luhi o ka ho'oikaika 'ana*, be careful, lest the wearisomeness of the effort be in vain. (PPN 'elo.)
- A'e Loa. n.** Name for the trade wind. See *ex.*, *ki'eki'e*. Cf. *A'e* 2, *Moa'e*, *welo* 1.
- a'e nei. Just now, lately; nearby, not far; ordinary, insignificant.** *E like me ka'u i 'ōlelo a'e nei*, just what I just said. *Ua hele a'e nei*, just now gone. *Ma'ō a'e nei nō*, just over there, not far. *Kahi 'eha a'e nei nō*, just a minor pain. *Kahi 'ike a'e nei nō*, nothing outstanding about the knowledge.
- ae'o. n. 1.** Stilts. **2.** Hawaiian stilt bird (*Himantopus mexicanus knudseni*), an endemic subspecies of stilt, formerly common on the main Hawaiian Islands, endangered. Also *kukuluae'o*. **3.** Same as *kTholo* 1, wood fishhook. *Kaua'i*.
- 'ae o hope. n.** Train of a dress (origin uncertain). (Kam. 76:99.)
- 'ae.'oia. vi.** To be well supplied with comforts and necessities. *He nohona 'ae'oia*, a well-supplied way of life. *Ua 'ae'oia a'ela ka 'ohana*, the family has all it needs.
- 'ae-o-kaha-loa. n.** A kind of fine tapa, used in *kuni* and other ceremonies, as for divining with pebbles. Also *kaha-loa*, *pālau-anahu*.
- 'ae one. n.** Sandy beach.
- ā. ewa. vi. 1.** Thin, tall, spindly; to weave to and fro, as seaweed; to sway, as a branch or sea eddy. Cf. *ewa*, *māewa*. *Ulu maika'i a āewa hua 'ole* (Kep. 159), growing well but spindly and fruitless [of bananas]. **2.** Possessing a family or lineage. Cf. *ēwe* 1. *Hānau ka huelo māewa, he āewa kona* (KL line 525), born [those of] tail-end [junior] rank, they have their lineage.
- aha. inter.** Why? What? For what reason? To do what? To ask what? (*Aha* frequently follows *he* and is often written *heaha*; cf. Gram. 4.6, 8.5.) *He aha?* What is it? What? *He aha kēlā?* What is that? *He aha kāna?* What has he got there? What does he have to say about it?
