

- 'aha ho'o.kolo.kolo koa. n. Military court, court martial.
- 'aha ho'o.kolo.kolo ko'i.ko'i. n. Superior court.
- 'aha ho'o.kolo.kolo malalo iho. n. Lower court.
- 'aha ho'o.malu. n. Administrative body, assembly.
- 'aha ho'o.pono.pono i ka nohona. n. Court of domestic relations.
- 'aha ho'o.pono.pono wai.wai ho'o.ilinea. n. Probate court. *Lit.*, court settling inheritance property.
- 'aha.hui. n. Society, club, association, organization, company, convention. Various types are listed below.
- 'Aha.hui 'Euane.lio Pae 'Aina. n. A term used in 1911 for evangelical conference of all the islands.
- 'Aha.hui Hō.ikaika Kaliki.ano. n. Christian Endeavor Society.
- 'aha.hui ho.'ole wai 'ona. n. Temperance union. *Lit.*, society forbidding intoxicating liquor.
- 'aha.hui 'imi na'au.ao. n. Academy, learned society.
- 'Aha.hui Kanu Kō Hawai'i. n. Hawaiian Sugar Planters' Association.
- 'aha.hui kula Kā.paki (Sabati). n. Sunday School association.
- 'aha.hui malū. n. Secret society.
- 'Aha.hui Māmaka.kaua. n. Sons and Daughters of Hawaiian Warriors. *Lit.*, warriors' society.
- 'Aha.hui Mo'o.lolo Hawai'i. n. Hawaiian Historical Society.
- 'aha.huina. 1. n. Corporation, association. 2. (*Cap.*) vs. Congregational. *Rare.*
- 'Aha.hui Wāhine Kaliki.ano Hō.'ole Wai 'Ona. n. Women's Christian Temperance Union.
- 'aha hula.hula. n. 1. Assembly for ballroom dancing; a ball. 2. Ancient assembly for the *hulahula* religious ceremony.
- 'aha.hulu.hulu. n. Bristle worm, a hairy sea creature (*Eurythoe complanata*).
- 'ā.hai. n. Commemorative wooden or stone pillar (probably short for 'ā hailona, symbolic stone).
- 'ā.ha'i. vt. To carry off, chase, rout; to flee, run away. *Ka 'āha'i 'ana i nā po'e ha'iha'i kānāwai*, the pursuit of lawbreakers.
- 'ā.ha'i.ha'i. Redup. of 'āha'i. *Na ka manu 'āha'iha'i, kanu lau 'awa o uka* (song), it was the birds who carried, planting kava leaf in the upland.
- 'ā.ha'i.kapu.puhi. vi. To go with the wind, to disappear completely. *Ua 'āha'ikapupuhi mua akula ka 'eu'eu Ko'olau* (Kel. 55), clever Ko'olau had completely vanished.
- 'aha iki. n. Small gathering for private conversation; small or secret council, as called in an emergency.
- 'ā.ha'i.lono. nv. Reporter, messenger, bringer of news; in legends, the sole survivor of a disastrous defeat who reports the news; to tell news.
- aha.'ina. Short for *aha 'ia ana*. See *aha*.
- 'ā.ha'ina. Same as 'āha'i.
- 'aha inu. n. Drinking party, as 'aha inu waina, wine-drinking party, 'aha inu lama, rum party.
- 'ā.ha'i 'ō.lolo. nv. Messenger; to carry word.
- 'aha ka'a.puni. n. Circuit court.
- 'aha kā.kau. n. Court of records.
- 'aha kapu. n. 1. A sacred assembly. 2. Sacred sennit cord belonging to a high chief and kept on a high place before his house; trespassers entering the house were killed if the cord remained in place, but if it fell down and the stranger stepped over it, this was a token of the stranger's high rank or kinship with the owner of the cord. Some chiefs had several such cords, each given a name, and some were used after the owner's death in making the *kā'ai*, container for his bones.
- 'aha kau kā.nā.wai. n. Session of the legislature.
- 'aha kau.like. n. An 1854 name for the highest court.
- 'aha kau.oha. n. Probate court.
- 'aha.kea. n. 1. Native trees (species of *Bobea*) with small to medium-sized, oblong leaves; small greenish or white flowers; and small, purple-to-black juicy fruits. The wood is yellow and formerly was used for poi boards and canoe rims. *I ke aha ho'i? I ka 'ahakea*. Why then? The 'ahakea [a saucy retort containing a pun on the word *aha*, what]. 2. Same as *haokea*, a taro.
- 'aha.kea lau li'i. n. A small-leafed 'ahakea (*Bobea elatior* var. *brevipes*).
- 'aha.kea lau nui. n. A large-leafed 'ahakea (*Bobea elatior*).
- 'aha kōne.koa. n. Senate.
- 'Aha Ki'e.ki'e. n. Supreme Court.
- 'aha kiule ki'e.ki'e. n. Grand jury.
- 'Aha Ko'i.ko'i. Same as 'Aha Ho'okolokolo Ki'eki'e. *Lit.*, powerful court.
- 'aha.kū. n. Cord used for measuring, as in laying out a garden or house. *Ho'omoe 'ia mai ka 'ahakū*, now lay down the measuring line.
- 'aha kuhina. n. Cabinet, assembly of ministers.
- 'aha kū.kā. n. Council meeting, discussion meeting, advisory council, conference.
- 'aha kū.kā malū. n. Privy council, secret deliberative meeting.
- 'aha lima.lima. See *limalima*.
- 'aha.lua.like. n. Rectangle. *Lit.*, two equal sides.
- 'aha luna.kahiko. n. Presbytery, meeting of elders.
- 'aha luna.kā.nā.wai. n. Judiciary session, meeting of judges.
- 'aha maha. n. Place or assembly for practice of athletic games, as sham fights. *Lit.*, assembly for relaxation.
- 'aha.maka. n. 1. Hammock, as of tapa, fastened to the *manuea*, center support of a house; hammock in general. *Lit.*, sennit meshes. 2. Cord with which edges of cracks in gourd bowls were sewn together in criss-cross patterns suggestive of net mesh; the technique for such repair. 3. Strangling in *lua* fighting, as with green vines. 4. Secret meeting of priests to pray for a chief.
- 'aha.mele. n. A yellow-spotted needlefish.
- 'aha mele. n. Concert, song concert, song festival.
- 'aha.moa. n. 1. An assembly watching a *lua* contest of the kind called *hakakā-a-moa*. 2. A cord made from the entrails of an enemy killed in a *lua* fight of the *hakakā-a-moa* type.
- 'aha moku.puni. n. Island conference, with representatives from a single island, especially of Congregationalists.
- ahana. Same as *ahahana*.
- 'aha nī.ole. n. Inquisition, inquest. 'Aha nītele kumu make, coroner's inquest.
- 'aha nina.ninau. n. Court of inquiry.
- 'aha.niu. n. A native sedge (*Machaerina mariscoides* subsp. *meyenii*) with pointed, leathery leaves about 90 by 1.6 cm, mostly basal around a more or less zigzag spike, which bears light-brown scattered flower clusters. See also 'uki, all species of *Cladium* and *Machaerina*. (Neal 89.)
- 'a.hao. Probably similar to *hao* 3, 4. (For. 6:472.)
- 'aha.'ō.lolo. nv. Legislature, assembly, council meeting, congress; to hold such meetings; to serve in the legislature.
- 'aha.'ō.lolo kau kā.nā.wai. n. Legislature, lawmaking body.
- 'aha.'ō.lolo lā.hui. n. Congress of the United States; national assembly.
- 'aha.'ō.lolo luna.kahiko. n. Conference of elders.
- 'aha.'ō.lolo nui. n. Congress.
- 'aha o nā luna.kā.nā.wai 'ā.pana. n. District court.
- 'aha pae.'āina. n. Convention of delegates from all the islands, especially as held by the Hawaiian Evangelical Association of Congregational Christian Churches.
- 'aha.pi'i. n. A kind of tapa dyed with *kukui* bark and decorated with fine lines, for chiefs.
- 'aha pule. n. Congregation, prayer assembly.
- 'aha 'uao ('uwao). n. Board of arbitration.
- 'aha 'ula. n. Council of chiefs. *Lit.*, regal meeting.
- 'ahawa. Waterhead, beginning of a water-course; to overflow. (AP.)
