

- ao loa**. n. Long cloud; high or distant cloud; stratus cloud along the horizon. *Fig.*, a distinguished person.
- a'o loko**. n. Innermost teaching, inspiration. *I ka ha'alele 'ana aku i Kou a'o loko 'ana mai*, from the neglect of Thy inspirations.
- 'ao lū'au**. nv. Unexpanded leaf blade of taro; to offer as a sacrifice. *E 'ao lū'au a kaulima*, offer young taro leaves five times as sacrifice.
- 'ā. one**. nvs. Sandy; sandy soil.
- 'a. ono**. num. Six, especially in counting in a series; six times. *Pō'aono*, Saturday; *lit.*, sixth day.
- ā 'ō. 'ō**. See *ā 2*.
- 'ā. o' o**. vs. Elderly, middle-aged. Cf. *o' o*.
- ao 'ō. nohi**. n. Cloud with rainbow (*'ōnohi*) colors.
- a'o pala.pala**. nvt. Instruction, education; to teach or learn writing.
- a'o pili.'ō. lolo**. nvt. Grammar, instruction in grammar; to teach or learn grammar.
- aouli**. n. 1. Firmament, sky, blue vault of heaven. 2. Var. of *'ōuli*.
- Ap**. Abbreviation for *'āpana*, land parcel, used in surveying.
- 'apa**. 1. vt. To delay, waste time, tarry, linger, keep others waiting. *Kahuli ihola lāua, a lilo ihola lāua i ke kā, i ka hoe, pēlā lāua i 'apa ai* (FS 49), the two upset, and were occupied with the bailer and paddles, in this way they were delayed. *Mai 'apa mai 'oe, e hele kākou*, don't dillydally, let's go. *Kū ka 'apa iā Hawai'i, he moku nui*, it is fitting for Hawai'i to tarry [do as it wants], a big island. **hō.'apa**. Caus/sim. 2. Ephah. *Biblical*. 3. (*Cap.*) Also **Aba**. Abba. (Mar. 14.36.) *Eng.*
- 'ā. pā**. n. 1. Roll or ream, as of paper; bolt, as of cloth. 2. See *lima 'āpā*.
- 'ā. pa'a**. 1. nvs. Arid, dry; dry area, clod of dirt. *Pili ho'ōla ka ua i ka 'āpa'a*, akin to a healer is the rain to the arid plains. (PPN *pakaka*.) 2. n. Land one has lived on for a long time (a term of affection related to *pa'a*, firmly bound). 3. Same as *wao 'ilima*.
- 'ā. pa'a. kuma**. n. Native of a place and descendant from its earliest line of chiefs. (Malo 24.)
- 'apa.'apa**. 1. Redup. of *'apa 1*; to procrastinate, deliberate, slow. **hō.'apa.'apa**. To slow down others; to lag, dillydally, bother. *He 'aumakua ho'oluhi, hō'apa'apa i ke kahuna*, a family god who bothers and interferes with the priest. 2. nvt. Guile, deceit; to practice such. (1 Pet. 2.22, Roma 1.25.) See *'apake'e*.
- 'Ā. pa'a. pa'a**. 1. n. Name of a strong wind associated with Kohala, Hawai'i. 2. (*Not cap.*) vs. Dry, parched. 3. (*Not cap.*) Same as *'āpa'a 2*. 4. (*Not cap.*) n. A kind of lobster (no data). 5. (*Not cap.*) vs. Firm, hard, compact. See ex., *mahani*.
- 'ā. pa'a. pana**. n. Small pieces, fragments. Cf. *'āpana*.
- 'ā. pa'a. pāna**. n. Delay, procrastination.
- 'ā. pa'a. pani**. nvi. Quick, effective repartee; to retort thus. *Rare*.
- ā . . . paha**. See *paha 6*.
- 'ā. paha**. vi. To doubt; perhaps, maybe. *Rare*.
- 'apa. hū**. *Rare* var. of *pahū*, explosion.
- 'ā. pahu**. 1. nvt. To cut squarely off, chop; a piece cut off at right angles. *Po'o 'āpahu*, head with receding forehead. 2. Same as *kūnehi*, a sunfish. 3. Conspicuous, as one dressed oddly. (And.) 4. To cram, pack full, stuff (And.)
- 'apai**. Same as *pai 5*, a fish trap.
- 'apa. kau**. vt. To seize, lay hold of, disarrange, displace; to spread, as sunlight. *Ka 'apakau 'ana iho o nā kukuna o ka lā maluna o ka 'ili o ke kai*, the spreading of the rays of the sun on the surface of the sea.
- 'apa. ke'e**. nvs. Deceit, dishonesty; deceitful, corrupt, inaccurate.
- 'ā. pala**. n. Apple (*Pyrus malus* syn. *M. sylvestris*). (Neal 388.) *Eng.* Also *poma*.
- 'ā. pali**. vs. Hilly, craggy. *Fig.*, impertinent, rude.
- 'ā. pali. pali**. 1. Redup. of *'āpali*. 2. To hurry, hasten. (And.)
- 'ā. pana**. 1. Piece, slice, portion, fragment, section, segment, installment, part, land parcel, lot, district, sector, ward, precinct; chop, as of lamb. A *kuleana*, land division, may consist of several *'āpana*. Cf. *kapa 'āpana*. *Kōmike komo 'āpana*, visiting committee, as of a church. (PCP (*k*)*a*)*pana*: cf. Marquesan *apana*.) 2. Same as *mile 1*. (Kam. 76:45.)
- 'ā. pana ipu lepo**. n. Potsherd. (Ioba 2.8.) *Lit.*, portion of earthen container.
- 'ā. pana kā. nā. wai**. n. Phylactery.
- 'ā. pana. pana**. Redup. of *'āpana*; fragments, pieces; to cut into pieces (For. 5:591). *Nā pōkā 'āpanapana*, shrapnel.
- 'ā. pana pō. 'ai**. n. Segment of a circle.
- 'ā. pane**. 1. n. A kind of *lehua* tree with dark-red flower. 2. Short for *'apapane*, a bird. See *'ōhi'a 'āpane*. 3. vs. Red, flushed, blushing.
- 'ā. pani**. nvt. To block, shut. *Fig.*, an unwelcome visitor who monopolizes conversation.
- 'ā. pani. ani. ani**. n. Window pane.
- 'ā. pani. pani**. Redup. of *'āpani*, to block.
- 'ā. papa**. n. Stratum, flat, especially a coral flat.
- 'ā. papa. lani**. n. 1. Legendary upper stratum and abode of the gods (preceded by *ke*). 2. Chiefs of the highest rank, as *nī'auipi'o*; gods. *E ala, ē 'āpapa nu'u, e ala, ē ke 'āpapa lani!* (UL 196). Awake, gods of high station, awake, gods of highest station!
- 'apa. pane**. n. A Hawaiian honey creeper (*Himatione sanguinea*), with crimson body and black wings and tail, found on all the main Hawaiian Islands. Its feathers occasionally were used for featherwork. Also *'akakane*.
- 'apa. papa**. Same as *laupapa 1*, reef.
- āpau**. idiom. All, entirely. *Nā kānaka āpau*, all the people, everyone, everybody.
- 'ape**. n. Large taro-like plants (*Alocasia macrorrhiza*, *Xanthosoma robustum*). (Neal 156, 162.) A number of beliefs concerning *'ape* have been recorded. *'Ape* was planted by a gate or fence because the irritating sap of the leaves was thought to ward off evil spirits; leaves were placed under tapas or mats on which the sick lay for the same reason. *'Ape* was not planted near the house for fear the residents might become sick. Varieties are qualified by the colors *kea* or *ke'oke'o* (white), or *hiwa* or *'ele'ele* (dark). (PPN *kape*.)
- 'ape. 'ape**. 1. n. All endemic species of *Gunnera*, huge-leaved forest perennial herbs, with thick, prostrate stems rising at the tip to about 120 cm. (Neal 651.) Called *hāhā* on Kaua'i. 2. vs. Elastic, flexible, limber. *Rare*.
- 'ā. pe'a. pe'a**. 1. Same as *pe'ape'a*, bat. 2. n. An unidentified cephalopod. 3. Same as *'ōpe'ape'a 3*, half leaf.
- 'ā. pe'e. pe'e**. *Rare* var. of *līpe'epe'e*, a seaweed.
- 'ā. peke. peke**. n. The Kaua'i *'elepaio* (*Chasiempis sandwichensis sclateri*).
- 'ā. pela**. vs. Old, aged. *Rare*.
- 'ā. pele**. n. Volcanic lava or ejecta of any kind, rough lava, lava flow.
- 'apele. koka, aperekoka**. n. Apricot (*Prunus armeniaca*). (Neal 396.) *Eng.*
- 'Ape. lika, Aferika**. Africa; African. *Eng.*
- 'Ape. lila, Aperila**. April. *Eng.*
- 'ā. peu**. Same as *'āleuleu*; long coarse mats used to hold food.
- 'ape. 'ula**. n. Kind of tapa, wrapped about images. (Kam. 64:12.)
- 'ā. peu. peu**. Same as *'āleuleu*. *He wahi 'āpeupeu moena ka'u i lawe mai nei*, I've just brought some ordinary coarse mats [a polite way to disparage a gift that may actually be fine].
- 'api**. 1. n. Soft spot in the temples; soft part of the human body between the pelvic cone and the lowest rib; under part of an animal's body (sometimes preceded by *ke*). 2. nvi. A surgeonfish (*Acanthurus guttatus*), 20 cm long. (PPN *hapi*.) 3. nvi. Fish gills; to breathe through gills. 4. vi. To palpitate, throb, tremble, shake, quiver;
