

- ka'a.hina. vi. To fall down and roll.
- ka'a.hō.kai. vt. To mix up, disturb. Cf. *hōkai*.
- ka'a.holo. vi. To speed ahead, run.
- ka'a.holo.hau. n. Sled. *Lit.*, car riding snow.
- ka'a.hope. Arrears in a payment; to pass by. *Ma ka Sabati iho nei i ka'a hope a'e*, on the past Sabbath.
- ka'a.huila.kahi. n. Wheelbarrow.
- ka'a.huila.lua. n. Any two-wheeled vehicle, as cart or buggy.
- ka'a.huki. n. Handcart. *Lit.*, pull vehicle.
- ka'ahu'ula. n. A *lua* fighting stroke. *Lit.*, the feather cloak. (Also without *ka-*.)
- kā'ai. 1. nvt. Sash, belt, girdle of any kind; sennit casket alleged to contain the bones of Līloa and Lono-i-kamakahi, in Bishop Museum in 1976; protective cloth wrapped around an object; to bind, tie around, encircle, gird on; to put on, as armor or a mourning garment. Also *kā'ei*, *kāhei*. See *akua kā'ai*. *Ho'i 'o Keawe, kū i ke kā'ai* (saying), Keawe returns, [his remains] bound in the sennit container [formerly said of newly dead]. (PPN *takai*.) 2. vt. To dig food crops, as taro, sweet potatoes.
- ka'aka. n. Fellow, chap, wretch, person. *Slang*. (Possibly Tahitian, but see *mahumahu*, 'ōkole *ka'aka*.)
- ka'a.kā'a. 1. vt. To open, as the eyes; open, watching. *E noho 'oe e ka'aka'a i ka hale*, stay and watch the house. *E ka Haku ē, i ka'aka'a ko'u mau maka* (Mar. 10.51), Lord, that I might receive sight. *ho'o.kā'a.kā'a*. Caus/sim. *Rare*. (PCP *takataka*.) 2. (Cap.) n. Name of a star or constellation, said to be on the border of the Milky Way. (KL line 1865.) 3. *Rare* variant of *ko'a*, coral head, fishing grounds.
- ka'a.kā'a. ho'o.kā'a.kā'a. To cause to roll repeatedly. Also *ho'okaka'a*. (PPN *takataka*.)
- ka'a.kā'a.hiki. vs. Actively and gainfully employed, successful; to make progress. *Rare*.
- ka'a.kā'a.lā'au. Same as *hi'u wīwī*, an 'ahi, a fish.
- ka'a.kā'a.lalo. Redup. of *ka'alalo*. (Kep. 101.)
- ka'a.kā'a.lawa. vs. To have enough, especially of material goods; ample. *Ka'aka'alawa ka papa e pa'a ai ka hale*, there is ample lumber to complete the house.
- ka'a.kā'a.lina. vs. Tough, stringy, as of banana trees; viscid, gluey.
- ka'a.kā'ana. Redup. of *ka'ana*.
- ka'a.kā'a.wili. Redup. of *ka'awili*. *ho'o.kā'a.kā'a-wili*. Redup. of *ho'oka'awili*. *Ho'oka'aka'awili ihola 'oia no kona 'eha'eha*, he writhed much in his pain.
- ka'a ka lolo. See *ka'a l*.
- ka'a.kaua. 1. nvi. Skilled in warfare; strategist, war maneuvers, strategy. 2. n. War tank; war chariot. (Puk. 14.25.)
- ka'a.kau.ō (kauwō). n. Trailer, tractor.
- ka'a.kepa. nvt. Diagonal, cut at an angle; to avoid, shy away from, take a short cut. See ex., *keha*. *No laila e ka'akepa nei, 'e'ena i ka pili kēpau* (hula song), that's the reason for being so shy, fearful of the sticky gum.
- ka'a.kewe. n. Cable car.
- ka'a.kinai.ahi. Fire engine. *Lit.*, vehicle extinguish fire.
- ka'ā.kolu. vs. Three-stranded; threefold.
- ka'a.ko'o. vt. To belt. *E pono e ka'ako'o i ka lolo ma ke kino me ke kā'ei*, the garment should be belted on the body with a belt.
- ka'a.kua. nvi. Violent dizziness; to lie down or lean back in pain, to roll over backwards. *Ka'akua ka lani, ho'loli ka honua* (chant for Ka-māmalu), heaven leans back in pain, earth is in travail.
- ka'a.kukua. Redup. of *ka'akua*.
- ka'a.kū.mā.kēna. nvi. Period of mourning, especially wailing in grief; to mourn and wail.
- ka'a.kumu. vs. Dull, of tools.
- ka'a.kupa.pa'u. n. Hearse.
- kaala. n. Widow, widower. (And.)
- ka'a.lā. 1. Same as *mo'o 'alā*, a lizard. 2. vs. Blind (used with *maka*). *Rare*.
- kā'alā. n. An 'opihi, a limpet.
- kā'alā. nv. Sling; to hurl stones with a sling. *He nui ka po'e i a'o i ke kā'alā*, many persons learned to use a sling.
- ka'a.lā'a. *Rare* var. of *kā'ala'ala*.
- kā'alā'ala. vs. Vigorous, sturdy, healthy, as of an infant or young animal. *I ke kā'ala'ala 'ana a'e o ke keiki . . .* (Nak. 6), upon the vigorous growth of the child . . .
- ka'a.lā'au. v. To wield a war club; to send a curse by playing with seeming innocence with four or five sticks held in the hand (Kam. 64:141).
- ka'a.lalo. vi. To sail to leeward. *Fig.*, full of lies, underhanded, deceitful. Cf. *ka'aka'alalo*.
- ka'a.lani. n. Those about a chief; members of the royal court. *Honi nā kini i ka makani Pa'ala'a, he hanu no ke ka'alani ē* (chant for Ka-mehameha I), the multitude smell the *Pa'ala'a* breeze, a breath of air for those about the chief.
- ka'a.lau. Same as *hukilau*.
- ka'a.lau.niu. n. Coconut-leaf thatching. *'O ka hana ho'i a nā ali'i wāhine 'o ka ulana i ka'a lau niu hale no ke ali'i*, the work the chiefesses did was to plait coconut thatching for the house of the chief.
- ka'a.lawe.ma'i. n. Ambulance.
- ka'a.lole. vi. To sway, reel; to fly or soar, as birds.
- ka'a.lolewa. Redup. and intensifier of *ka'alewa*. *Nā ao ka'alewa* (1 Tes. 4.17), floating clouds.
- ka'a.lōo. vi. To speak loudly.
- ka'a.lewa. vi. 1. To revolve. 2. To drift, sail off and on. Cf. *kālewa*.
- ka'a.lia. Pas/imp. of *ka'a l*, 3-5. *Rare*. *ho'o.kā'a.lia*. Pas/imp. of *ho'oka'a*. *Ho'oka'alia mai ke alo o ka moku ia'u nei* (Kep. 184), let the front of the island be turned toward me.
- kā'ali'i. nv. Ceremonial throwing of spears at a high chief returning from a voyage; he dodges or catches the spears to show his courage and skill; to hurl thus.
- ka'a.lina. vt. To bruise; to pelt, as rain. Cf. 'ālina.
- ka'a.lio. n. Horse-drawn vehicle, wagon, carriage.
- kā'alo. vt. To pass by, go by. Cf. *mā'alo*. *ho'o.kā'alo*. To pass to and fro, to cause to pass. (PPN *ta(a)kalo*.)
- kā'alo'alo. Redup. of *kā'alo*.
- ka'a.lohi. Same as *ka'alolohi*.
- ka'a.loku.loku. nvs. Intrepid, fearless, as of one unafraid to brave the elements; bravery. (FS 239.) Cf. *loku*.
- ka'a.lolo. n. Name of a star, said to be the tutelary star of Ni'ihau.
- ka'a.lolohi. vs. Slow-moving, slow to anger. *Kū i ka 'ena o ka lani nei ali'i, 'o ka lani ka'a lolohi, ka'a ka lani* (chant for Ka-mehameha I), this chief is filled with regal fury, the chief usually slow to anger, the way of a chief.
- ka'ā.lua. vs. Two-ply, two-stranded.
- ka'a.luna. vi. To sail or turn against the wind. *Fig.*, to dominate; overbearing. Cf. *ka'alalo*.
- ka'a.māhu. n. Steam-propelled vehicle.
- ka'a.ma'i. nv. Siege of sickness, a long or chronic illness; to suffer such. *Lō'ihi ke ka'a ma'i 'ana*, the siege of sickness was long.
- ka'a.malalo. vi. 1. To fall in (military command), to serve others, to roll beneath. 2. To be subject to. *Kōmike e ka'a aku malalo o ke 'āpono 'ana . . .*, committee subject to approval . . .
- ka'a.malo'o. vt. To wipe dry, as dishes with a cloth.
- ka'a.maluna. vi. To rise in station, to come up from under; to rule others.
- ka'a.meā. vi. To change, as the wind or an idea. *Rare*.
- ka'a.meha'i. Var. of *kāmeha'i*.
- ka'a.moena. nv. Bedridden. *Rare*.
- ka'a.mola. vi. To turn around loosely, as a screw or peg that does not fit; loose, unsteady.
- ka'ana. 1. vi. To divide, share, apportion. *ho'o.kā'ana*. To divide equally among, share. 2. vi. To decoy, especially to attract *uhu* fish with a live *uhu* decoy; to
