

- tafa*.) 2. loc. n. Place (often followed by a qualifier, as *kahakai*, *kahaone*, *kahawai*, and used without *ke*, as *hele i kahakai*, go to the beach); in legends, a hot dry shore (PH 74, 84; FS 173). (Gram. 8.6.) 'O *kēia ka mea ulu o ko'u kaha*, this is what grows on my place. (PPN *tafa*.) 3. vi. To swoop, as a kite; to be poised, soar, as a bird (less used than *kitkaha*); to go by, pass by, to turn and go on; to surf, body surf (FS 153). *Kaha ka lā ma ke kua o Lehua* (UL 238), the sun passes to the back of Lehua [Island]. **ho'o.kaha**. Caus/sim. (PEP *ta(f,s)a*.) 4. vt. To desolate, plunder, cheat. Cf. *pākaha*. *Ua kaha akula ka nalu o ku'u 'āina*, the waves of my land have swept everything away [said of famine]. **ho'o.kaha**. Caus/sim.; to extort. 5. n. Stage of a foetus in which limbs begin to develop. Also *mana*. 6. vs. Proud, haughty. *Rare*. See *ho'okahakaha*. 7. n. A kind of tapa. (Kam. 76:111.)
- kā.hā**. vs. Large, fat, plump, as of a well-fed dog. *Rare*.
- kaha akua**. n. 1. A track of a god. 2. Abode of gods or spirits.
- kaha.apo**. n. Circumference, parentheses, brackets. *Lit.*, mark embrace.
- kaha.ea**. See *kaha I*.
- kaha.'ea**. n. Cumulus clouds, often colored, thought to be a sign of rain. Cf. *ao*, 'ōpua. *Kau kaha'ea i ka hana waele; palepale nā 'auwai o lalo*, the cumulus clouds appear during the task of weeding; clean the water-courses down below.
- kaha.'ea.'ea**. Redup. of *kaha'ea*. *I ke kau kaha'ea'ea a ke aloha*, the cumulus clouds of love are set.
- kaha.emi**. n. Minus sign.
- kahaha**. 1. n. Young growth stage of the fish 'ama'ama, about a hand's length. Also *pahaha*. 2. Same as *auka-ha*, desolate.
- kā.hā.hā**. interj., n., and vi. Interj. of surprise, wonder, displeasure; to wonder, be surprised, astonished, amazed, puzzled; surprise, astonishment. *Kāhāhā i ka 'ino*, shocked, aghast, horrified. *Kā i ke kāhāhā nui* (Kel. 104), most astonishing. **ho'o.kā.hā.hā**. Surprising, astonishing; to cause astonishment.
- kaha.hā.nai**. n. 1. Radius of a circle. 2. Strings securing upper part of the net surrounding a calabash (*kōkō*).
- kaha.hiō**. n. Multiplication sign, crisscross mark; slanting lines.
- kaha ho'o.lawē**. n. Minus sign.
- kaha ho'o.nui**. n. Multiplication sign.
- kaha.hui**. n. Bracket combining two items, as male and female voices in music; tenor clef; plus sign in arithmetic. *Lit.*, joining mark.
- kā.hai**. Var. of *kā'ai*.
- Kaha'i**. n. A culture hero. (PNP *Tafaki*.)
- kā.ha'i**. Same as *kanaha'i*.
- kā.ha'i.ha'i**. 1. Redup. of *kāha'i*. 2. Same as 'āweoweo, a native shrub.
- Kaha-i-Kaha'i**. n. Star name, said to be the twentieth in the Milky way. *Lit.*, going to Kaha'i [hero's name].
- kā ha'i makē mai ho'i**. n. Death by sorcery. *Lit.*, death indeed from someone else. (Kam. 64:43.)
- kaha.'ino**. nvs. Evil, evil place. *Haele ana nō kānaka i ke kaha, alualu ana i ke ka'i o kaha'ino ē* (For. 6:469), people go to the place, following the guidance of evil.
- kahaka**. n. Plant said to have been used for medicine (no data).
- kaha.kā**. vs. Disagreeable, unpleasant. *Ka'ū*.
- kaha.kaha**. 1. Redup. of *kaha I*; to mark frequently, to draw lines, scratch; to cut lengthwise or into strips; to scarify, engrave; striped, lined. *Pepa kahakaha*, scratchpaper, lined paper. **ho'o.kaha.kaha**. Caus/sim. *Me ka ho'okahakaha 'ana i ka lau i ka lima* (For. 5:663), with the separation of the leaves in the hands. (PPN *tafatafa*.) 2. Redup. of *kaha 3*. **ho'o.kaha.kaha**. Caus/sim.; to parade back and forth, make a display or exhibition; to show off, act the dandy; to drill, as a fire drill; parade, celebration, exhibition, display, vanity, pomp; superb, showy. *Lā ho'okahakaha*, holiday. (PEP *ta(f,s)ata(f,s)a*.) 3. n. Small stone larger than a pebble. *Rare*.
- kaha.kahana**. n. Markings, scratchings, lines, stripes; narrow strip of cloth, usually white. *Kahakahana lole* (Ioane 11.44), napkin. *Kahakahana kaumaha*, marks of worry, as on the face.
- kaha.kai**. loc. n. Beach, seashore, seacoast, seaside, strand. (Gram. 8.6.) (PEP *tafatai*.)
- kaha.kau.pale**. n. Boundary.
- kaha.keā**. vs. High, inaccessible, as a cliff. (For. 6:412.)
- kaha.kele.awe**. nv. To cut or engrave in copper or brass; a worker in copper or brass; engraver.
- kaha.ki'i**. nv. To draw or paint a picture or draw plans; artist.
- kaha.ki'i.hale**. nv. Architect; to draw building plans.
- kaha.kiki**. nvs. Roaring sound, as of wind, rain, or rushing waters; to roar. *Ua lohe akula lākou i ke kahakiki a ka wai*, they heard the roar of rushing water.
- kaha.kō**. 1. vs. Steep, sheer. *Ka pali kahakō lele a koa'e*, sheer cliff reached by tropic bird. 2. n. Macron.
- kaha.kū**. 1. vi. To turn off one's course; to go where one pleases, trespass. *He kahakū wau no kēia 'āina, ia'u o uka, ia'u o kai* (FS 235), I may go where I please on this land, inland is mine, seaward is mine. 2. n. A unit of measure, usually said to be about 2.5 m, but in FS 97 called fifteen feet (4.5 m).
- kaha.kuhi**. n. Reference mark in writing or printing to direct attention, as asterisk, dagger, arrow, blaze.
- kā.hala**. 1. n. Amberjack or yellowtail (*Seriola dumerilii*). *Kāhala 'ōpio* is *S. aureovittata*. The name may be qualified also by *maoli* and *moku lei*. *Āmuka* is a variant name or a name for the adult stage. Another name is *mokule'ia*. See also *halahala 2*. 2. vs. Ripe, said of a gourd with stem beginning to wither. *Ua kāhala ka ipu*, the gourd is ripe. 3. n. Net made of strong cord, used for sharks. (Malo 213.) Also *hihi mand*.
- kā.hala.hala**. vs. Tasteless, insipid, flavorless, unpleasant tasting. Cf. *hala*, fault.
- kaha.lalo**. nvi. Underscore, underline.
- kaha.lelele.pō**. n. Famine during wartime, with persons seeking food at night for fear of being seen. *Lit.*, cut leap about night.
- kaha.lili**. 1. n. Sanctified stone used by a priest in 'anā'anā sorcery. 2. vi. To exhibit wrath or displeasure due to jealousy.
- kaha.loa**. 1. Short for 'ae-o-kaha-loa, a tapa. 2. A stone brought before a priest in sorcery prayers. (And.)
- kaha loa**. nvi. To turn and then go straight for a long distance; long detour or digression.
- kaha.maha**. vt. To interrupt, break into a conversation.
- kaha maha**. n. Dash (punctuation mark). *Lit.*, mark to rest.
- kaha.mekala**. nv. To engrave; engraver.
- kaha.moē**. n. Hypphen. *Lit.*, horizontal mark.
- kahana**. n. Cutting, drawing of a line; turning point. Cf. *kaha I, 3*. *Eia ma'ane'i ke kahana alanui e iho ai i kahakai*, here's the turn of the road to go down to the beach.
- kā.hana.hana**. n. Clearing, as in a forest; redup. of *kahana* (For. 6:61). *Ka'ū*.
- kā.hana.hana.pali**. n. Cliff ledge. (For. 6:61.)
- kaha.nalu**. n. Body surfing. Cf. *kaha 3*.
- kaha.nia**. vs. 1. Smooth-shaven, smooth, unclouded. *Kahania ke po'o o ka 'ōhule*, the head of the bald man is smooth. 2. Sour, as of poi.
- kaha.one**. loc. n. Sandy beach.
- kaha.pala.pala.'āina**. v. To draw a map. *Mea kaha palapala'āina*, cartographer, topographer.
- kaha.pe'a**. nv. To make a cross or X, especially in black magic (the victim becomes gravely or mortally ill by stepping on or over the mark); to crisscross; a cross or X.
- kaha.pili**. n. Tangent of a circle. *Lit.*, line that touches.
