

- ness. *Po'e ho'okele moku*, ship crew or navigators. *Ho'okele 'ino*, to speed, drive, sail recklessly. *Ho'okele-'ale*, name of a navigation star. *Ho'okele-wa'a*, the star Sirius. *Ho'okele ka'a*, chauffeur, driver; to drive a car. *Ho'okele wa'a lolo niu*, to sail coconut bloom sheaths as [toy] canoes. (PNP *tere*.) 3. vt. To scrape cooked taro with 'opihi shell or spoon after peeling is removed, to clean it in preparation for pounding. 4. Var. of *kela 1*. 5. n. A fresh-water weed. 6. n. Any kind of wild taro. *Rare*. 7. n. Jelly, jam. *Eng*.
- kele. ho'o.kele.** Kind of stone found at craters, as *Ki-lau-ea*, and used for adzes.
- kelea.** n. Process by which a priest cleansed himself of impurities (*kele*) from contact with the dead.
- kele 'ai.** Var. of *kale 'ai*.
- kele.awe.** nvi. General name for metals, as brass, copper, bronze, tin, steel, lead. *Ku'i keleawe*, metalsmith, one who makes brass, copper or tin articles; to work with these metals.
- kele.kalama.** nvt. Telegram; to send a telegram or cable. *Eng*.
- kele.kalapa, kelekalepa, telegarapa.** nvt. Telegraph; to send a telegram or cable. See song, Elbert and Mahoe 61.
- kele.kele.** 1. Redup. of *kele 1*; mud, mire, muck, slush, fat oil; muddy, oily, rich, greasy. *Nā kōhi kelekele o Ka-pu'u-kolu* (song), the fat delicious food of The-triple-hills [descriptive of rich, sumptuous fare]. **ho'o.kele.kele.** To make muddy; to sprinkle; to soak material, as pandanus leaves, in water to make pliable for plaiting; to feed, fatten, especially with soft food or liquids. (PCP *teletele*.) 2. Redup. of *kele 2*. **ho'o.kele.-kele.** Redup. of *ho'okele*; to steer, navigate or sail frequently; to manage; to cast, as for fish. *Ho'okelekele ka'a*, to drive a car; chauffeur.
- kele.kona, delekona.** n. Dragon. Also *kalekona*.
- kelelo, kelerō.** n. A lot, in casting lots. *Biblical*. (Gr. *kleros*.)
- kele lua.** vs. Excessively damp, wet, muddy, greasy, fat, etc.
- kelema, kerema.** n. Consecrated oil and balm, as used in confirmation services; chrisom. (Gr. *chrisma*.) *Ke kopilimakio aku nei au iā'oe me ke kerema o ke ola*, I confirm you with the chrisom of life.
- Kele.mā.nia.** 1. nvs. Germany; German. *Eng*. 2. (*Not cap.*) n. Earthen crock as used for poi, said to have been introduced from Germany.
- kele.mā.nia 'ai.** n. Poi crock.
- kele.moio.** Same as *momona*, the cherimoya. Probably *Eng*.
- kele.momeka, teremometa.** n. Thermometer. *Eng*.
- kele.pona, telepona.** nvt. Telephone; to telephone. *Eng*.
- Kele-wa'a.** Var. of *Ho'okele-wa'a*, the star Sirius. See *kele 2*.
- kele.wai.** n. Coarse tapa, as made from *māmaki* bark or from the waste of better grade tapa.
- kele wai.** vs. Thin, as watery poi; muddy, as water. **ho'o.kele wai.** To use much water in mixing or pounding poi, or in irrigation.
- kele waina.** Grape jelly. *Eng*.
- kele.wī, kele.wiki.ona.** n. Television. *Eng*. Also *kīwī*.
- keli.koli, teritori, teritore.** nvs. Territory; territorial. *Eng*.
- keli.liona, teriliona.** num. Trillion. *Eng*.
- keli.luma kelemanā, deliruma teremana.** n. Delirium tremens. *Eng*.
- keli.uma, deliuma.** Bdelium. *Eng*.
- kelo.** vs. Slimy, foul with snot; slippery, as thick mucus. Cf. *hākelo*.
- kē.lō.** Interj. Sail ho! *Eng*.
- kelo.kelo.** Redup. of *kelo*. Cf. *hākelo*.
- keloko, keroko.** n. Saffron. (Mele 4.14.) (Gr. *krokos*.)
- kelo.kokile, kerokodile.** n. Crocodile. *Eng*.
- kelola, derora.** n. Swallow (bird). (Sol. 26.2.) (Hebrew *deror*.)
- kē.lou.** nvt. Hook; to hook. Cf. *lou, kīlou*.
- kē.lū, selu.** n. Quail. (Puk. 16.13.) The usual name is *manu kapalulu*. (Heb. *selaw*.)
- kelu.ika, deruida.** n. Druid. *Eng*.
- keluka, terusa.** n. Thrush. *Eng*.
- kelu.kake, kerusade.** n. Crusade. *Eng*.
- kelu.koliko, kerusolito.** n. Chrysolite. (Hoik. 21.20.) (Gr. *chrysolithos*.)
- kelu.kope.lako, kerusoperaso.** n. Chrysoprase. (Hoik. 21.20.) (Gr. *chrysoprasos*.)
- kelupa, keruba.** n. Cherub. (1 Nal. 6.24.) *Eng*.
- kelu.pima, kerubima.** n. Cherubim. (Puk. 25.19.) *Eng*. See ex., *malumalu*.
- keme.pulu.** Var. of *kamipulu*.
- kemika.** nvs. Chemist; chemical. *Eng*. *Hana kemika*, chemistry.
- kemo.kalaka, demokarata.** nvs. Democrat; democratic. *Eng*.
- kemu.** 1. vt. To absorb, consume. *Kemu Wai-mea i ka ua kukupa'u o Hanakahi*, Wai-mea absorbs the pouring rain of Hanakahi. 2. n. Game. *Eng*. 'O ka'u kemu 'ike kēia, 'o ka ho'onoho papa kōnane (hula song), this is the game I know, how to set the kōnane board.
- kena.** vs. 1. Quenched; satisfied, of thirst. See ex., *puehu 1*. *Inu ā kena*, drink until satisfied. **ho'o.kena.** To satisfy thirst. 2. Weary, as from heavy toil; grieved and distressed.
- kē.nā.** 1. vt. To command, order, give orders, summon, send on business. *Kēnā akula 'o Ka-mehameha i kona po'e kānaka e 'imi lā'au 'ala*, Ka-mehameha sent his people to look for sandalwood. 2. demon. That (near the person addressed). Used disparagingly for "you." *He aha kāu, ē kēnā mo'o!* What's that to you, you reptile! Cf. *kēlā*, Gram. 8.3. (PPN *ena*, PNP *teenaa*.)
- kena.kena.** 1. Redup. of *kena 1, 2*; satiated, surfeit. 2. n. Unpleasant stifling sensation of inhaling smoke; suffocation from smoke.
- kenā.kenā.** Redup. of *kēnā 1*. **ho'o.kenā.kenā.** To compel, order.
- kenali, denari.** n. Penny. (Eng. *dinar*.) (Mat. 20.2.)
- ke** (verb) **nei.** Part. denoting present tense near the speaker. Cf. *ke* (verb) *lā* and Gram. 5.3. 'O wau 'o Kamika, ke ho'ohiki nei au, I, Smith, do hereby affirm. (PCP *te* (verb) *nei*.)
- keneka.** n. Cent, penny. *Eng*.
- kene.kile, genetile.** n. Gentile. *Eng*.
- kene.koa.** n. Senator. *Eng*.
- kene.kulia, keneturia.** n. Century. *Eng*.
- kene.lala, generala.** n. General. *Eng*. *Hope kenelala*, adjutant general.
- kenele.** n. Canary. *Eng*.
- Kene.maka.** nvs. Denmark, Dane; Danish. *Eng*.
- keni.** 1. vi. To walk softly so as to make no noise. *Rare*. 2. n. Change (money), small change. *Eng*. *He keni nō kāu?* Have you change?
- kenika, tenisa.** n. Tennis. *Eng*.
- keni.keni.** 1. vt. To assemble a complete outfit or set, as of furniture, food, fishing gear, clothing. *Rare*. 2. n. Knife. *Rare*. 3. n. Dime, ten cents, small change, means. (Eng. *ten*.) 4. n. A variety of imported white sugar cane; also called lahaina cane.
- keni.mekela.** n. Centimeter. *Eng*.
- ke.nola, tenora.** Tern. *Eng*.
- ke'o.** 1. vs. White, clear. **ho'o.ke'o.** To whiten, bleach. 2. n. Clitoris. 3. vs. Proud, haughty. *Rare*. 4. vi. To project. *Rare*. Cf. *pake'o*. (PCP *teko*.)
- keoe.** n. 1. A sweet potato. 2. (*Cap.*) Probably the constellation Lyra, including the star Vega. *Keho'oea* may be a variant.
- ke'o.ke'o.** 1. nvs. White, clear. *Kālā ke'oke'o*, silver money. *Ke ke'oke'o mai o ka nalu*, the whiteness of the (breaking) waves. *E 'ike ai ka mahi 'ai i ke ke'oke'o* (Kep. 91), the farmer sees clearly. **ho'o.ke'o.ke'o.** To whiten. (PCP *tekoteko*; cf. Marquesan *tekoteko*.) 2. n. White muslin (usually followed by *maoli, pia*, or *wai*). 3. vs. Proud. *Rare*. (PEP *tekoteko*.)
