

- la'a ua. n. Rainy season.
 lā.'au 'ai. n. Chopsticks.
 lā.'au 'aila. n. Castor-oil plant; *Lit.*, oil plant. Also *koll*, *pā'aila*, *ka'apehā*, *kamākou*.
 lā.'au 'ala. n. Fragrant wood, especially sandalwood.
 lā.'au ali'i. n. Children of chiefs by second matings; their children were termed *la'a uli*. (Kam. 64:6.)
 lā.'au ana. n. Yardstick, ruler, surveying rod, measuring stick.
 lā.'au hamo. n. Salve, ointment. *Lit.*, rubbing medicine.
 lā.'au hā.nō. n. 1. Asthma medicine. 2. Jimson weed (*Datura stramonium*), a cosmopolitan weed, related to *nānāhonua* (*Brugmansia candida*), a coarse annual herb with white or pale purple or blue trumpet-shaped flowers 5 to 10 cm long and spiny fruits about 5 cm long. The plant is strongly narcotic and poisonous. A drug called stramonium, extracted from dried leaves and flowering tops, is used to treat asthma. Also *kitkānia*, *kitkānia haole*. (Neal 750.)
 lā.'au hihī. n. Vine.
 lā.'au hili. n. Switch, club.
 lā.'au ho'o.hanu.hanu. n. Inhalant.
 lā.'au ho'o.hia.moe. n. Drug, narcotic, soporific, medicine to cause sleep, chloroform.
 lā.'au ho'o.ikaika. n. Tonic, any medicine that strengthens.
 lā.'au ho'o.ka'a. n. Rolling pin, any wooden roller.
 lā.'au ho'o.kani pahu. n. Drumstick. *Lit.*, drum-playing stick. Cf. *'uha moa*, chicken drumstick.
 lā.'au ho'o.lua'i. Same as *lā'au ho'opi'i*.
 lā.'au ho'o.make mū. n. Insecticide. *Lit.*, medicine to kill insects.
 lā.'au ho'o.mā.lie.lie. n. Tranquilizer.
 lā.'au ho'o.malule kino. n. Narcotic, drug. *Lit.*, medicine to relax the body.
 lā.'au ho'o.moe. Same as *lā'au ho'ohiamoe*.
 lā.'au ho'o.nahā. n. Cathartic medicine.
 lā.'au ho'o.noe.noe. n. Drug, as opium. *Lit.*, befogging plant.
 lā.'au ho'o.pā. n. Medicine to prevent fecundation.
 lā.'au ho'o.pi'i. n. Emetic. *Lit.*, medicine to make come up.
 lā.'au ho'o.pi'i.pi'i. Same as *lā'au ho'opi'i*.
 lā.'au ho'o.polo.lei. n. Splint.
 lā.'au ho'o.wali 'ai. n. Implement for mixing poi or *poi palaoa*.
 lā.'au hope. n. After endpiece of a canoe.
 lā.'au hū. n. Any gum-producing tree or plant, as candlenut, spruce.
 lā.'au ihu. n. Bow endpiece of a canoe.
 lā.'au iki 'ai 'ia. n. Edible herb. Cf. Roma 14.2. *Lit.*, small eaten plant.
 lā.'au ka'a. n. Cypress (RSV), fir tree (KJV) (Zek. 11.2); terebinth (RSV), elm (KJV) (Hos. 4.13); conifer.
 lā.'au kaha. n. Boom of a vessel. *Lit.*, turning stick.
 lā.'au kā.heā. n. A type of faith healing of broken or crushed bones or sprains. *Lit.*, calling medicine.
 lā.'au kahi hā. n. One-by-four lumber.
 lā.'au kala.kala. n. Lantana. *Lit.*, thorny plant. See *lākana*.
 lā.'au Kaliki.maka. n. Christmas tree.
 lā.'au kā.pala.pala. n. Bamboo stamp for marking tapas. *Lit.*, printing stick.
 lā.'au ke'a. n. Wooden cross or crucifix; bar to hold a gate shut, brace, bolt.
 lā.'au kī. n. Bar to hold a gate shut, bolt. Cf. *kī*, key.
 lā.'au kia. n. Stick for snaring birds. Cf. *kia manu*.
 lā.'au ki'i. n. Easel.
 lā.'au kini.pō.pō. n. Ball bat of any kind.
 lā.'au kū. n. House post, post, doorpost; mast. *Rare*. Cf. *pou*. *Lit.*, standing stick.
 lā.'au ku'i. n. Ladder, tree with crosspieces used as a ladder (PH 174). *Lit.*, joined wood.
 lā.'au ku'i kopē. n. Coffee huller.
 lā.'au ku'i palu. n. Wooden *palu* pestle.
 Lā.'au Kū Kahi. n. Eighteenth day of the lunar month.
 Lā.'au Kū Lua. n. Nineteenth day of the lunar month.
 lā.'au kumu 'olē. n. Parasite. *Lit.*, plant without foundation. A legendary *koa* tree with this name at Kahiki-kolo, Kaua'i, was said to have only branches and no trunk.
 lā.'au kū.pē'ē. n. Stocks, wooden fetters, handcuffs. *Lit.*, bracelet sticks.
 la'a 'ula. n. Autumn. *Lit.*, red time [of leaves].
 lā.'au lā.lau mēa 'ai. n. Chopsticks.
 lā.'au lalo. n. Boom of a vessel. Cf. *lā'au kū*. *Lit.*, down stick.
 lā.'au lapa.'au. n. Medicine. *Lit.*, curing medicine.
 la'a uli. n. Sacred or doomed darkness, ignorance, gloom, the unknown, misfortune. Cf. *la'a kea*, *lā'au ali'i*.
 lā.'au li'i.li'i. n. Small bush, plant, or stick.
 lā.'au lōke (rose). n. Rosewood.
 la'a ulu. n. Spring, time of growth. (Kep. 89.)
 lā.'au lua hā. n. Two-by-four lumber.
 lā.'au mā.ka'i. n. Policeman's club.
 lā.'au make. n. Poison.
 lā.'au moe. Same as *lā'au ho'ohiamoe*.
 lā.'au moe.kū. n. Wooden bedstead.
 lā.'au 'ō.hiki.hiki niho. n. Toothpick. *Lit.*, stick to pick teeth.
 lā.'au 'o'oi. n. Bramble, briar, thorny tree.
 lā.'au pae.pae. n. Boom of a vessel.
 lā.'au pahe'ē. See *pahe'ē 3*, dart-throwing.
 lā.'au pahu.pahu. n. Billiard cue. *Lit.*, billiard stick.
 lā.'au pā'i kini.pō.pō. n. Ball bat, tennis racket, ping-pong paddle; any kind of paddle for slapping a ball. *Lit.*, stick for beating ball.
 lā.'au pā.lau. n. Fighting club.
 lā.'au palu.palu. n. Herbs, tender vegetables.
 Lā.'au Pau. n. Twentieth day of the lunar month.
 lā.'au pauka makika. n. Punk for mosquitoes. *Lit.*, stick mosquito powder.
 lā.'au pi'i. Var. of *lā'au ho'opi'i*.
 lā.'au pili. n. Name of a gambling game. *Lit.*, betting stick.
 -la'a wa'a. ho'o.la'a wa'a. Blessing of a canoe launching; to dedicate a canoe.
 lae. n. 1. Forehead, brow. *Nalulu ka lae*, to have a headache. (PPN *la'e*.) 2. Cape, headland, point, promontory. (PEP *la'e*.) 3. Wisdom; mental or emotional qualities. Cf. *lae o'o*, *lae pa'a*, *lae 'ula*, and idioms *pohā 1*; *po'ohū 1*. ho'o.lae. To pretend to be wise; to act smart; pretentious. 4. An insulting term, followed by qualifiers, referring to *kauā*, outcasts, who had dots tattooed on their foreheads (Malo 70-2). Cf. *lae kiko*, *lae mamo*, *lae puni*.
 la'e. Same as *la'ela'e 1*; pure in sentiment (Hal. 19.8). Cf. *kāla'e*. ho'o.la'e. To clear up, brighten. (PCP *lake*.)
 la'e.hana. interj. Syllables repeated in chants at ends of verses to mark time and for gay effect, similar to *ehehene*.
 lae.hao.kela. n. Unicorn, rhinoceros. *Lit.*, brow with protruding horn.
 lae.hina. Same as *noio*, a tern. *Lit.*, white brow.
 lae honua. vi. To bow low, as the head. *Lit.*, earthward forehead.
 lae kiko. n. *Kauā*, outcast, with a dot tattooed on the forehead. *Lit.*, dotted forehead.
 lae.koloa. n. Type of hard, red stone, as used for adzes. Also *humu'ula*.
 lae lā.'au. n. Forested point, whether at sea or inland. See ex., *kilokilohia*.
 la'e.la'e. 1. vs. Bright, shiny, clear, serene, calm, pleasant. *Ho'oku'u la'ela'e*, set at liberty, freed [as after a verdict of "not guilty"]. ho'o.la'e.la'e. Redup. of *ho'ola'e*. (PCP *lakelake*.) 2. n. A variety of sweet potato. (HP 142.) 3. (Cap.) n. Name of a star.
 lae lae. interj. Syllables repeated in songs at ends of verses to mark time and for gay effect, similar to *la'e-hana*.
 lā.'ele. n. Old leaf, ready to fall or beginning to dry (a contraction of *lau 'elemakule*, old leaf). *Fig.*, aged; old age. *Mai ka liko a ka lā'ele*, from leaf bud to old leaf.
